§205. Organization of corporation

- 1. Organizational meeting. An organizational meeting must be held before or after incorporation in accordance with this subsection.
 - A. If initial directors are named in the articles of incorporation, the initial directors shall hold an organizational meeting, at the call of a majority of the directors, to complete the organization of the corporation by appointing officers, adopting bylaws and carrying on any other business brought before the meeting.  - B. If initial directors are not named in the articles of incorporation, the incorporator or incorporators shall hold an organizational meeting, at the call of a majority of the incorporators:
 - (1) To elect directors and complete the organization of the corporation; or

- 2. Action permitted without organizational meeting.
